The FAMS major is comprised of a **minimum of 9 approved courses**, including:

- One foundational course (**F**) in Film and Media Studies (FAMS 101);
- at least one course in film and/or media history (**H**);
- at least one course in film and/or media theory (**T**);
- at least one course in film and/or media practice (**P**);
- a capstone (**C**) project/course that emphasizes the integration of theory and practice (FAMS 401)

FAMS majors, via close consultation with program advisers, build depth and focus into their specific course of study. In dialogue with their advisers, students select elective courses that best suit their interests, e.g. choosing to focus on global issues in FAMS, cinema history, new media, or documentary production. Individual courses may not count for more than one category (F, H, T, P, C).
